How to Get Started Volunteering

- ❖ Visit the District's O.N.E. webpage at <https://bit.ly/2rAjkb1> or scan the QR Code above.
- ❖ Choose "For Volunteers" on the left.
- ❖ Under Step 1, select your child's school, create an account and fill in an application.***



If you think you'll be volunteering in the classroom often or going on a field trip, also do Step 2 (criminal background check).



When school starts, log into your account at myimpactpage.com and sign up for specific opportunities!

Frequently Asked Question's

I don't see anything to sign up for. Why? Please be patient. It takes time at the beginning of the school year to assess the needs of each classroom. Field trips are usually posted throughout the year as they approach. Keep logging into your account at myimpactpage.com to check for updated opportunities.

I have a criminal background check card with an expiration date. Do I need another criminal background check? These cards are meaningless. You can discard them. Criminal background checks remain in good standing as long as a person volunteers at least one time per school year with us. If you have volunteered yearly, you do NOT need a new check. If you've missed a year or years, you should resubmit a new criminal background check online. The volunteer coordinator will likely check with you to be sure of your status.

How come I don't see my child's field trip posted online for sign up? Not all field trips need chaperones. Sometimes space is limited or there is no need for extra help. Please remember that field trips are a learning experience and too many new or familiar faces can be distracting. Most field trips are to places where parents and their children can go together on their own time at a later date.
