



What is CIPA, COPPA, and FERPA?

CIPA: Children's Internet Protection Act

- Schools provide filtering to help protect students from harmful materials such as obscene images.

COPPA: Children's Online Privacy Protection Act

- Websites must seek parental permission before collecting personal information from children under 13.
- Schools can act as an agent for parents for contracted services, such as Google Apps.
- A permission form can be used for schools to act as an agent for parents for non-contracted educational tools or services

FERPA: Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act

- Parents and Students have access to:
 - Grades
 - Student ID
 - Attendance Data
 - Photos
- Schools cannot share student records with other students or parents without parent permission.
