Facilities Use Request COVID-19 Mitigation Practices

In collaboration with the WIAA, state and local health agencies, and the Wisconsin Valley Conference, the Wausau School District has put into place a number of COVID-19 mitigation practices in an effort to safely allow participation in activities that utilize our facilities. As a condition of approval to utilize District facilities, we are requiring any organization or group follow the same guidelines as our staff and students.

1. **Participants** -- should monitor their own health and if they have these symptoms, should not attend the event on a given day.
 - a. Temperature: 100.4 or greater
 - b. Cough
 - c. Shortness of Breath
 - d. Difficulty Breathing
 - e. New loss of taste
 - f. New loss of smell

Or at least two of the following:

 - a. Fever
 - b. Body Aches
 - c. Sore Throat
 - d. Congestion or runny nose
 - e. Nausea or vomiting
 - f. Diarrhea
 - g. Chills
 - h. Headache
 - i. Fatigue
2. **Face Coverings** -- Wear a face covering that covers both your nose and mouth. This includes spectators and athletes.
3. **Hand sanitizer and/or sanitizing wipes** -- Participants will provide their own hand sanitizer (at least 60% alcohol) and/or sanitizing wipes. Everyone is encouraged to sanitize their hands upon arrival and immediately after events.
4. **Water and Restrooms** -- Participants are expected to bring their own water and should be prepared to have enough water to last the entirety of the event. District restroom facilities will be available, but participants are strongly encouraged to address personal hygiene needs prior to their arrival and to minimize the use of restrooms.
5. **Locker Rooms** -- Locker rooms will not be available.
6. **Spectators** -- Limit spectators to essential people only. Consider a limit of 2-4 spectators per athlete. Spectators will engage in social distancing while observing events and will wear face coverings.
