Individual, Couples and Family Therapy

Our agency offers individual, couples, and family therapy. Therapy services are designed to help children and adults deal with a variety of issues affecting their lives such as anxiety, depression, life changes, behavior problems, trauma, grief or loss, ADD/ADHD, sexual abuse, physical abuse, relationship difficulties, divorce adjustment problems, parenting issues, etc.

We accept and submit claims to most private insurance plans and medical assistance for our services. We also offer a sliding fee scale for those without insurance.

Substance Abuse Counseling

Peaceful Solutions Counseling provides assessments and effective counseling/treatment for individuals (adults and teens) abusing or addicted to chemical substances. Other services include, individual and group counseling for both teens and adults, relapse prevention, alcohol and drug education, and family support services

The CHOICES Program

The CHOICES Program is a comprehensive program for teens that are experiencing problems with alcohol and drugs.

Depending on the need of the individual, we are able to provide individual, group, or family sessions. It is our goal in the CHOICES program to help teens develop skills to avoid harmful risks, prevent and reduce the misuse of alcohol and drugs, improve access to behavioral health screening and effective treatment programs. We accept referrals from a variety of sources.

The VOICES Program

The VOICES Program is an 18 week group for female adolescents from ages 11-17 and focuses on issues of self-discovery, empowerment, support and motivation for personal self-awareness and growth. The program is based on research and clinical experience developed by Stephanie Covington.

The S.A.F.E. Program

The SAFE program is a group therapy program that provides education/therapy for adults who have been emotionally or physically abusive in their intimate relationships.

The program accepts referrals from a variety of sources including self-referral, therapists, and the judicial system.

The Butterfly Program

The Butterfly Program is a one-time education/therapy session for the children between the ages of 6-17 whose parents are currently going through a divorce or separation. This 3 hour session helps children understand how divorce affects them, learn skills to handle their reactions to it, and helps them see that they are not alone.
